English

RE

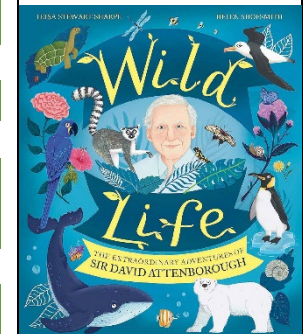
RE this term we continue to explore the life of Muslims, looking at sacred festivals, celebrations and important dates in their calendar,
