		<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Students will write 'Overcoming the Monster' stories for a class anthology, critically explore the ethics of bullfighting, and create persuasive adverts to campaign against it. Join us for a journey of creativity and debate!</p>	<p><b>Key Texts</b></p>
		<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Children will master geometry by identifying and drawing 2-D and 3-D shapes, understanding angles, and recognising patterns with lines and shapes. They will also develop data skills through creating and interpreting pictograms and bar charts, and organising information in two-way tables.</p>

		<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Students will embark on a journey to locate Spain and its vibrant regions on the map, using geographic terms to describe its position relative to other countries. They'll discover that countries like Spain are comprised of various regions, each boasting unique geographic features.</p>	
		<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Pupils will create their piece of art in the style of Andy Warhol. They will focus on creating a piece of art of their chosen landmark.</p>	
		<p><b>PD / RE</b></p> <p>In RE the children will evaluate what it means to be a Christian in Britain today. In Personal Development they will learn how to identify different types of relationships and the importance of communication, coping with emotions and body image.</p>
