**English**

Year 5 will be exploring poetry and describing both a journey and a setting. We will continue to develop our reading skills by reading a wider range of texts linked to our topic and genre, and to practice and improve our spelling and handwriting skills.

**Maths**

We will be looking more closely at how to use the four operations with decimal numbers before moving on to negative numbers. In our final weeks we will convert different units of measurement before learning about volume, while continuing to use our skills to develop our reasoning skills and learning how these skills will help us in the future.

**Science**

Our topic this term is living things and their habitats, building on our living things topic earlier in the year, we will develop our knowledge of animals to include single celled organisms including bacteria, fungi and viruses.

**Humanities**

We will locate North and South American, and European countries and cities on a map. They will then learn about different biomes across the world, honing in on Brazil’s Amazon Rainforest.

**Art/ DT**

Year 5 will explore the processes needed to make bread before designing and creating their own variety. We will look at what makes a food healthy and how we can have a healthy diet.

**PD/ RE**

In RE this term we will learn about Hinduism and what it means to be a Hindu. While in PD we will be looking at aspirations for the future, how we can continue to learn and contribute to the wider community.

**PE**

Year 5 will be working towards our Knockhall sports day, practicing different athletic activities including shotput, relay racing, sprinting and races that use a range of multi-sport skills.
