Visionary Victorians

Big Bang

This term Big Bang Day will be 23rd April and we would welcome the children to come dressed as a Victorians! We cannot wait to see you costumes!

Trip/ Visit

	English	We will be focusing on Oliver Twist. This will include writing character descriptions and writing in role as characters. In addition, we will be focussing on non-fiction writing in the form of explanation and information texts.
	Maths	The children will continue learning about fractions such as adding and subtracting fractions. They will also learn fractions of objects and an amount with reasoning. We will also cover adding and subtratin money as well as converting pounds and pence.
-	History	In this topic the children will learn about the Victorians. We will learn about the monarchy and significant events on a time line. We will cover Queen Victoria and other Kings and Queens before her. We will also learn about the rich and poor divide and work houses, school and slavery. We will also teach them the link between British history that extends beyond their knowledge of 1066.
	Art/DT	We will be learning how to sketch. We will be revising light and shade and we will be looking at how to draw facial features, followed by applying this to a portrait of Queen Victoria.
	Music	The children will be learning basic skills in playing the Ukelele and should perform simple pieces with them.
	Computing	In this unit, the children will learn about building network knoweldge. We will recap childrens kowledge of basic network components and their functions. We will then explore more complex networks such as networks with multiple devices.
	R.E.	For this unit of work, the children will recap what does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? We will also be comparing the Hindu, Muslim and Christian faith communities.
	P.E.	This term we will be focussing on cricket. We will be learning about the skills needed to play a match. We will be practising for sports day.
	Personal Development	We will be looking at healthy choies and habits. We will also look at what affects our feelings and how we can express them. This will link to health and wellbeing.
