Ruthless Romans

English

Our children will be writing a narrative based on the book 'Escape from Pompeii', which has a historical focus. The children will focus on description of a setting and using senses to create suspense. The children will also write a persuasive text.

Maths

The children will start this unit by exploring denominators for unit fractions. From year 2, they know about halves, quarters and thirds and with this unit they will now look at fractions with different denominators. We will also look at measuring, measurements, mass and capacity.

History

Children will learn about the Romans and that they were an ancient civilisation from 753 BC to 476 AD. They will learn about their empire across Europe, North Africa and the Middle East. We will look at their architecture, art, engineering and organisation. They will see how they had an impact on today.

Art/DT

The children will be continuing to develop their joining skills in textiles. They will design and create their own Roman tunic inspired by their history topic. The children will progress through the DT process of designing, creating and evaluating.

Music

All the learning in this unit is focussed around one song, 'The Dragon Song'. Using their imagination and working as a class, they will create their own performance of this song.

Computing

In this unit, the children will use the swift playground app and use different tools and buttons to create and modify characters and change backgrounds.

R.E.

For this unit of work, the children will look at the different religious and spiritual ways of life including prayer.

P.E.

The children will be enjoying orienteering and dance.

We will be looking at how to assess information online, safely and then look at different job types, focussing on stereotypes and then looking at personal goals.
