Who Let the Gods out?

English

This term, children will be using their core book to support their learning about our topic 'Who Let the Gods out?' through their writing. They will be writing a Greek Myth based on Pandora's box and then also an information text.

Maths

Fractions: Children will be focusing on fractions which include identifying the numerator and denominator, finding fractions of a number, adding and subtracting fractions. They will also learn about decimals including dividing 1 and 2 digit numbers by 10. .

Science

Sound: This term children will be investigating sound including how sounds are made and how sounds travel.

Art/DT

Drawing - 3 D Art forms: Our focus will be 3d Art forms and the development of our drawing skills. The children will look at some of the art work produced by the ancient Greeks and attempt to recreate it. They will use the knowledge from their topic to design their own art works.

History

Ancient Greece: We will learn about the lasting impact of the Ancient Greeks on: democracy, architecture, art, mathematical and scientific thinking, culture and literature. They will look at the Athenians and Spartans in detail and their ongoing wars and look at how the Ancient Greek Empire expanded through invasions.

Computing

Swift Playground: In computing this term, children will be deepening their knowledge and skills in coding by using Swift 2, building on their previous learning.

R.E.

Right and Wrong: This half term, the children will be learning about different religions and their belief systems along with how these different belief systems can teach people about deciding what is right and wrong.

P.E.

Dance and Orienteering: Children will be practicing their dance skills through a series of dance styles from around the world and developing their orienteering skills through a different outdoor activity.
