Old Father Thames

English

Year 5 will be creating a letter and a diary using our Key text 'Floodlands' by considering a character's point of view. We will also be writing an explanation text based on our theme of rivers.

Maths

This term we will revisit fractions, learning how to multiply fractions by integers and other fractions. We will progress to use our prior knowledge to calculate fractions, decimals and percentages before moving on to calculating area and perimeter and finally looking into statistics.

Science

Our topic this term is Living things and their habitats. We will be focussing on life cycles and reproduction and how these differ in a range of animals and plants.

Geography

Our Geography topic is 'Old Father Thames'. This will include finding about rivers, their formation, impact and development surrounding them, as well as locating the rivers of the UK and the countries/ counties they are in.

Art/DT

Year 5 will explore circuits. We will investigate how circuits are made, what makes an effective circuit and how they can be modified to suit a purpose. This will enable us to make and design a product using our gained knowledge

Music

This term we will be learning about Hip Hop music. by learning about the beats and sounds that we hear in different songs.

Computing

We will learn how websites are built using HTML, the language that structures and displays content on web pages. We will explore basic skills like creating headings, adding text, links, and images, helping them understand how websites work.

In RE this term we will continue learn about the Muslim faith, as well as the teachings of religions and what we can learn from them..
